- Raise the cap on our policy
- Consider incorporating to avoid possible personal liabilities
- Post a "use at your own risk sign" at the canoe dock
- Review our policy every August with our agent for updates or revisions
- Speak to our agent about the fee that we are currently paying for liability on Scheper's building
- Contact Robinson and Stith Insurance Co. (Jimmy Robinson) to review our commercial policy. Lee highly recommended Jimmy Robinson because of his extensive experience and knowledge of commercial insurance.

John Murphy will schedule an appointment with Jimmy Robinson.

Larry gave an update on the playground initiative. This project is still in the research and development phase.

There was discussion about the condition of the life jackets at the canoe dock. John Murphy will speak to Bill Rounds about the possibility of having them inspected by the Coast Guard Auxiliary.
